# PRODUCT FACT SHEET

**ANDREAS BERGSAKER ON THE DESIGN** "FOCUS is an everyday object with a sculptural appeal and an apparent function: it is a lamp and a pedestal where your favorite small objects may be placed and highlighted. Working with the appearance and the delicate dimensions, I tried to give the lamp a unique personality characterized by an embracing and protective nature. The focus is on the pedestal and the object which is placed on it. Therefore, all components are fixed in position. Personally, the pedestal, with a cone of ambient light, solved my problem of misplacing my keys. Now I always know where they are."

## PROCESS

FOCUS lamp's wooden components are shaped on a lathe machine. The electrical parts are hidden inside the lamps components, which are glued together to hide that they were ever apart. Thereafter, the lamp is painted.

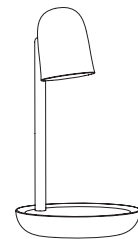
